





The Source - Prime Location in Southern California

The number of Korean Americans living in Buena Park increased by 57% from 2000 to 2010







Between 2010 and 2014, the number of Korean Americans living in Orange County increased by 16%




Growing Asian Population and Diversity






%: group's percentage of the total population of Orange County ref.: group's percentage of the total population of California



IRVINE, CA (September 26, 2016): This morning, the FBI released its Part I crime data for calendar year 2015. According to the data, the City of Irvine has the lowest rate of violent crime per capita of any City in the nation with population of 250,000 or more persons.

In 2016, the City of Irvine (19 miles away/20 minute drive from The Source) was ranked as the safest big city in the U.S.
